FEDERAL-AID
RESOLUTION TO CONSTRUCT BY CITY

Under the provisions of Title 23, United States Code, "Highways", as amended and supplemented.

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois, through its Department of Transportation, hereinafter called the STATE, and the City of Urbana, hereinafter called the CITY propose jointly to replace 437 inlet grates on various City Streets and to be designated as Illinois Project BGP-81(3), Section 80-00223-00-SP.

AND WHEREAS, the STATE and the COUNTY agree on the estimated cost of the improvement as follows:

AND WHEREAS, the STATE agrees to reimburse the CITY for a portion of the cost of the project upon the receipt and approval of the progress estimates;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the CITY will construct the project with its own forces in accordance with the plans, specifications and estimate approved by the STATE, under the Secondary Road Plan, and that reimbursement by the STATE will be for that portion of the cost payable from Federal-aid ~~Safety~~ funds ~~and the STATE'S share required to match the Federal-aid Safety funds~~ for the work performed, based on the unit prices shown herein;

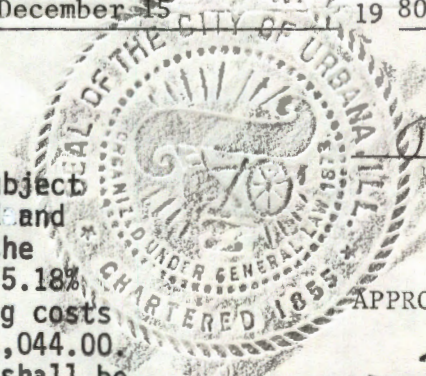
AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk is hereby directed to transmit four certified copies of this resolution to the STATE, through the office of the Regional or District Engineer at his office in Paris, Illinois, for its consideration and approval;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the approval of this resolution by the STATE shall be considered as its concurrence in and acceptance of the terms contained herein.


