

RESOLUTION NO. 8182-R12

A RESOLUTION
ESTABLISHING A RULE
FOR PETITIONS AND COMMUNICATIONS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:


1. That a new rule governing petitions and
communications by the public at any regular City Council meeting
be and the same is hereby established and adopted to read as
follows:

"Any person addressing the City Council during
petitions and communications shall be guaranteed at
least five (5) minutes for such petition and communication.
Following the expiration of the five (5) minute time
period, it shall be the prerogative of the chair to
enforce a limit on such petition and communication or
not, which such enforcement or lack thereof may be
subject to an appeal to the City Council and shall
be decided without debate by a majority vote of the
members of the City Council then present."

2. That this Resolution shall become effective
immediately upon its passage and approval.

3. This Resolution is hereby passed by the affirmative
vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a two-thirds (2/3rds)
vote of all the members of the Council of the City of Urbana,
Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 21st day of
September, 1981.
