

RESOLUTION NO. 8283-R16

A RESOLUTION
REGARDING STREET LIGHTING ON PORTIONS OF VINE AND COLORADO


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That the City Engineer, subject to and in accordance with both Division 2, entitled "Standards", of Article VII, entitled "Street Lighting System", of Chapter 20, entitled "Streets, sidewalks and other public places", of the Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Illinois, and the functional street classification system as contained in the City of Urbana 1982 Comprehensive Plan which was adopted by Ordinance No. 8283-17 on September 7, 1982 and approved on September 16, 1982, be and the same hereby is authorized and directed to initiate a request to and work with the Illinois Department of Transportation to effect a change in the design standards for the street lighting aspects of the proposed improvement on portions of Vine and Colorado to provide for such design standards as are consistent with the following:

1. Vine between Florida and Colorado and Colorado between Vine and Anderson: 70-watt high-pressure sodium semi-cutoff luminaires 20 feet high with an overhang beyond the curb of three or more feet, staggered and spaced about 170 feet to produce an average maintained horizontal illumination of 0.4 footcandle.

2. Colorado between Anderson and Philo: 100-watt high-pressure sodium semi-cutoff luminaires 20 feet high with an overhang beyond the curb of three or more feet, staggered and spaced about 170 feet to produce an average maintained horizontal illumination of 0.6 footcandle.
