A RESOLUTION  
ENDORSING A NUCLEAR FREEZE


WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois concurs with the conclusion made on July 24, 1982, by the U.S. Conference of Mayors to the effect that, as elected local officials, they were "alarmed by an international political climate that increasingly presents nuclear war as a 'rational' possibility."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That the City Council hereby endorses the following in order to call a halt to the nuclear arms race:

To improve national and international security, the United States and the Soviet Union should jointly and immediately stop the nuclear arms race. Specifically, such governments should adopt a mutual and verifiable freeze on the testing, production and deployment of nuclear weapons and of such missiles and new aircraft designed primarily to deliver such weapons.
