

RESOLUTION NO. 8283-R5

A RESOLUTION  
ASCERTAINING PREVAILING WAGES FOR THE  
PERIOD OF JULY 1, 1982 TO JUNE 30, 1983

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted "An ACT regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workmen employed in any public works by the State, County, City or any public body or any political subdivision or by any one under contract for public works," approved June 26, 1941, as amended, (Ill.Rev.Stats., Ch. 48, secs. 39s-1 through 39-12), (the "Act"); and

WHEREAS, the Act requires that the City Council of the City of Urbana investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in the Act for laborers, mechanics and other workmen in the locality of said City employed in performing construction of public works, for said City, exclusive of maintenance work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. To the extent and as required by the Act, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workmen engaged in the construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the City of Urbana is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in the Champaign County area as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois for the period of July 1, 1982

to June 30, 1983, a copy of such determination being attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. The definition of any terms appearing in this Resolution which are also used in the Act shall be the same as in the Act.

Section 2. Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction of the City of Urbana to the extent required by the Act.

Section 3. The City Clerk shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the City Clerk's Office of this City this determination of such prevailing rate of wage.

Section 4. The City Clerk shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed, or file their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workmen whose wages will be affected by such rates.

Section 5. The City Clerk shall promptly file a certified copy of this Resolution with the Secretary of State of the State of Illinois.

Section 6. The City Clerk shall cause to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the area a copy of this Resolution, and such publication shall

constitute notice that the determination is effective and that this is the determination of this City Council.

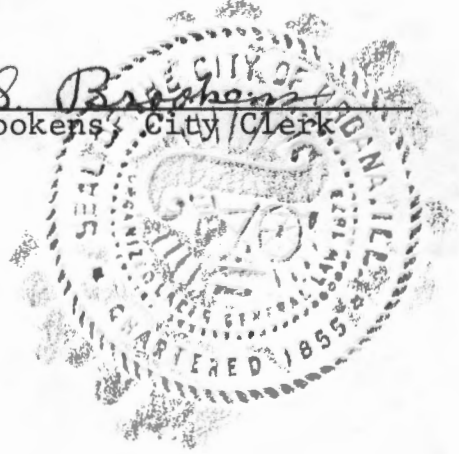

FOR CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION AND/OR REPAIR, INCLUDING PAINTING, REDECORATING AND LANDSCAPING OF PUBLIC BUILDINGS OR PUBLIC WORKS WITHIN THE STATE OF ILLINOIS WHICH REQUIRES OR INVOLVES THE EMPLOYMENT OF MECHANICS AND/OR LABORERS. MINIMUM WAGES, OVERTIME RATE AND FRINGE BENEFITS CERTIFIED HEREIN SHALL BE PAID AND THE SCALE OF WAGES TO BE PAID SHALL BE POSTED BY THE CONTRACTOR IN A PROMINENT AND EASILY ACCESSIBLE PLACE AT THE SITE OF WORK. THIS DETERMINATION IS THE PROPERTY OF THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND SHALL NOT BE ALTERED WITHOUT THEIR CONSENT IN WRITING.
