


RESOLUTION NO. 8283-R37

A RESOLUTION
REGARDING STREETLIGHTING ON SOUTH VINE STREET
BETWEEN COLORADO AVENUE AND HOLMES STREET

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

The City Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to request the Illinois Department of Transportation to add to the approved project for reconstructing Vine Street between Colorado Avenue and Holmes Street the installation of 70-watt high-pressure-sodium semi-cutoff luminaires 20 feet high with an overhang beyond the curb of three feet or more, staggered and spaced about 170 feet to produce an average maintained horizontal illumination of 0.4 footcandle with an average to minimum uniformity ratio not greater than 6:1, such addition to said project to be funded from Federal Aid Urban (FAU) and Motor Fuel Tax (MFT) funds.
