

RESOLUTION NO. 8384-R17

A RESOLUTION
CONCERNING PARTICIPATION IN THE
EAST CENTRAL ILLINOIS POLICE TRAINING PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Legislature and Governor of the State of Illinois in recognition of the importance of continuing to provide in-service training to law enforcement officers efficiently and effectively has passed and signed into law Public Act 82-674, known as the "Intergovernmental Law Enforcement Officers In-Service Training Act" to assist in funding mobile team in-service training units; and

WHEREAS, since 1977 law enforcement agencies in Champaign and Vermilion Counties have participated in a program of in-service training for law enforcement officers on a regional basis and this program qualifies as a mobile team in-service training unit; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Local Government Law Enforcement Officers Training Board which administers the Training Act is requiring the participating agencies and organizations to enter into an intergovernmental agreement pursuant to the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, Article 7, Section 10 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That the City of Urbana, Illinois, hereby agrees to enter into said intergovernmental agreement to participate in the East Central Illinois Police Training Project in cooperation with the other participating units of government within East Central Illinois.
