

\* RESOLUTION NO. 8384-R25

A RESOLUTION  
CONCERNING THE DEVELOPMENT OF A  
COMPREHENSIVE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the City Council hereby expresses its desire to cooperate with other units of local government to establish a Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan (the "Plan") for the entire community. To facilitate this expressed objective, the City Council hereby approves the expenditure of staff time and such other incidental costs and expenses as may be associated therewith.

Section 2. That the City Council, in order to proceed with the formulation of the Plan, recommends that a Solid Waste Planning Group (the "Group") be formed, such Group to consist of two voting representatives each from the Cities of Urbana and Champaign and one ex-officio non-voting member. In addition, one representative each from the County of Champaign, the University of Illinois, the Recycling Center, a potential energy consumer and the local haulers shall also be ex-officio non-voting members. The two voting representatives from the City of Urbana on the Group shall be selected by a majority of this City Council, and the ex-officio non-voting member of the City of Urbana shall be the Mayor.

Section 3. That the Group shall identify the various problems associated with local solid waste disposal and prepare a report recommending a specific course of action with respect to the following:

A. An assessment of the economic impact of the closing of the CUSWDS Sanitary Landfill in May, 1985, together with a recommendation for a temporary disposal alternative, such as the direct haul to other landfill sites, the construction and operation of a transfer station, or the extension of a 10-acre site located upon the existing sanitary landfill of the City of Urbana.

B. A determination of the size of the affected waste stream and, more specifically, the willingness and capacity of other agencies to participate in developing a permanent solution to solid waste.

C. A methodology for selecting a permanent disposal solution, including the type of procurement process to be utilized, the tentative timetable, and a budget for external costs such as consulting and other services.

D. An evaluation of the need to consider the control or further regulation of the present refuse collection system within the framework of the existing legal environment.

Section 4. That the Group shall forward its recommendations to each of the entities so represented on the Group within forty-five (45) days of the first meeting of the Group.
