

RESOLUTION NO. 8384-R39

A RESOLUTION OF PROTEST

WHEREAS, Tyrone Clapper, Champaign County Zoning Administrator, has petitioned the Champaign County Zoning Board of Appeals to amend the County Zoning Ordinance text to include a "temporary use" category, and

WHEREAS, the said proposal is being considered by the various governmental authorities concerned under the style and name of "Case No. CCZBA #504-AT-84, Amendment to the Champaign County Zoning Ordinance to Include a Temporary Use Category," and

WHEREAS, after due consideration of the proposed County text amendment, the Urbana Plan Commission has forwarded its recommendation to the Urbana City Council, which said recommendation is to the effect that the Urbana City Council should enter a protest to the proposed textual amendment to the Champaign County Zoning Ordinance contained in Case No. CCZBA #504-AT-84, and

WHEREAS, the Urbana City Council, having duly considered all matters pertaining thereto, finds and determines that the proposed textual amendment to the Champaign County Zoning Ordinance would not be in the best interests of the City of Urbana and its citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

1. The City Council finds and determines that the facts contained in the above recitations are true.
2. The Urbana City Council, on behalf of the said City, hereby resolves that the City of Urbana should, and hereby does, protest the proposed textual amendment as set forth in Case No. CCZBA #504-AT-84, urges that it not be adopted. Provided, however, the Urbana City Council, on behalf of the said

City agrees that no protest shall be lodged to the proposed text amendment in Case No. CCZBA #504-AT-84 if the final amendment contains the following changes:


A. In Section 5.2, Table of Authorized Principal Uses (of the proposed Ammendatory Ordinance), by deleting the words "permitted by right" and substituting the words "Special Use"; and

B. To maintain existing Special Uses under Section 5.2, Table of Authorized Uses, as they now exist in the Champaign County Zoning Ordinance; and

C. To maintain existing Section 6.1, Regulations for Specific Special Uses, of the Champaign County Zoning Ordinance.

3. The City Clerk of the City of Urbana is hereby authorized and directed to file a certified copy of this Resolution of Protest with the County Clerk of the County of Champaign and to mail a certified copy of this Resolution to the aforesaid Tyrone Clapper at 1905 East Main Street, Urbana, Illinois 61801 and Thomas J. Difanis, State's Attorney of Champaign County, Attorney for the Petitioner, at Champaign County Courthouse, Urbana, Illinois 61801.
