

RESOLUTION NO. 8485-R20

A RESOLUTION  
APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING  
THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
THE CITY OF CHAMPAIGN, THE CITY OF URBANA AND CHAMPAIGN COUNTY  
FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A LONG-RANGE SOLID WASTE PLAN

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That An Intergovernmental Agreement  
Between the City of Champaign, the City of Urbana and Champaign  
County For the Development of a Long-Range Solid Waste Plan, in  
substantially the form of the copy of said Intergovernmental  
Agreement attached hereto and hereby incorporated by reference,  
be and the same is hereby authorized and approved.

Section 2. That the Mayor of the City of Urbana,  
Illinois be and the same is hereby authorized to execute and  
deliver and the City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois, be  
and the same is hereby authorized to attest to said execution of  
said Intergovernmental Agreement as so authorized and approved  
for and on behalf of the City of Urbana, Illinois.

Section 3. That all resolutions and motions and parts  
thereof in conflict with this Resolution and the Intergovern-  
mental Agreement approved hereby are, to the extent of such  
conflict, hereby repealed, and this Resolution shall take effect  
and be in full force immediately upon its adoption and approval.

Section 4. That the City Clerk be and the same is  
hereby directed to send a copy of this Resolution and an  
executed copy of the aforesaid Intergovernmental Agreement  
approved hereby to the Chairman of the Champaign County Board;  
the Mayor of the City of Champaign; Richard Larson, Public Works  
Director of the City of Champaign; Robert Soltau, Executive  
Director, Champaign County Regional Planning Agency; and to  
Patrick Lawton, Administrative Assistant, City of Champaign.
