A RESOLUTION REGARDING PLANNING PROJECT PRIORITIES

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 8485-R21 A Resolution Respecting Signage on University and Cunningham Avenues, Resolution No. 8485-R28 A Resolution Respecting Certain Signage within the Corporate Limits of the City of Urbana, and Resolution No. 8586-R 23 A Resolution Amending Resolution 8485-R21 all set as a high priority matter directing the Plan Commission to study the appropriateness of existing sign regulations and the general physical appearance for areas specifically zoned B-3 General Business along University and Cunningham Avenues in the City of Urbana; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission on January 8, 1987, had considered planning project priorities and recommended City Council favor a downtown to campus study as a higher priority over the sign study as reflected in Plan Case #1247-RS-87; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the recommendation of the Plan Commission on Plan Case #1247-RS-87 and has found with subsequent public input that there is now greater need and it is in the best interests of the City to reprioritize the importantce of specific planning projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, as follows:

Section 1. That the following planning projects rank highest in priority (numerically, 1. ranking highest and 4. ranking lowest):

- 1. Downtown to Campus Study
- 2. Historic Preservation Study
- University and Cunningham Avenue Signs and Related Issues 3.
- 4. Extraterritorial Drainage Study

Section 2. Further, that the Plan Commission is directed to proceed with preparing appropriate studies and recommendations to City Council for each of the priority projects identified in Section 1., in their respective priority order.

Section 3. Further, that as part of priority 1., Downtown to Campus Study, the Plan Commission consider and report on the geographic locations for the potential designation of any historic preservation district(s) or site(s) and that prior to commencement of the study, a problem statement, study objectives and general study methodology first be reviewed and approved by the City Council.
