

RESOLUTION NO. 8889-R5

A RESOLUTION
REGARDING BRICK SIDEWALKS

WHEREAS, city ordinances encourage the preservation of existing brick sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, in some instances because such existing brick sidewalks are isolated stretches of brick, it is deemed to be in the best interests of the city to allow replacement of such with concrete sidewalks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That the following described sidewalks are hereby declared to be exempted from the city policy of preserving brick sidewalks and the Director of Public Works is directed to allow the replacement of such with concrete sidewalks:

1. in front of and abutting 206 and 208 E. California Avenue, Urbana, and

2. in front of and abutting 402 E. Green Street, Urbana, including that sidewalk abutting said address along Urbana Avenue.
