## SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT (No. 1)

This Supplemental Agreement, entered into this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_ A.D. 19 \_\_\_\_, by and between the State of Illinois, acting by and through its Department of Transportation hereinafter called the STATE, and the City of Urbana, of the State of Illinois, hereinafter called the CITY.

## WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the STATE and CITY have entered into an Agreement executed July 17, 1989, which sets forth certain provisions for improving F.A.U. Route 7177 (Lincoln Avenue) from north of Anthony Drive to Wilbur Road, and,

WHEREAS, the STATE and CITY desire to supplement said Agreement, and,

WHEREAS, the CITY is desirous of including additional improvements to the project in the way of relocating highway lighting and the construction of new sidewalk along the west side of Lincoln Avenue within the limits of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained here and in the Agreement executed July 17, 1989, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. The STATE agrees to pay all construction and engineering costs, subject to partial reimbursement by the CITY as hereinafter stipulated, for the addition of new sidewalk and relocation of highway lighting, as requested by the CITY.
- 2. The CITY agrees to reimburse the STATE for 50% of the STATE'S cost (plus 15% of said costs for engineering) for the construction of new sidewalks along the west wide of Lincoln Avenue from north of Anthony Drive to Wilbur Road. The CITY also agrees to reimburse the STATE for 100% of all costs (plus 15% of said costs for engineering) for the relocation of

- 2. (Contd.) highway lighting, as requested by the CITY. The total cost to the CITY for the addition of new sidewalk and relocating highway lighting is estimated to be \$8,000. Actual costs, based on contract unit prices and final quantities, shall be used in the final division of costs for billing and final reimbursement.
- 3. The CITY has passed a resolution appropriating sufficient funds to pay its share of the cost of this improvement, a copy of which is attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and made a part hereof. Upon award of the contract for this improvement, the CITY will pay to the Department of Transportation of the State of Illinois in a lump sum from any funds allotted to the CITY, an amount equal to 95% of its obligation incurred under this Agreement, and upon completion of the project, will pay to the said Department the remainder of the obligation (including any non-participating costs) in a lump sum, based upon final costs. The CITY agrees to pass a supplemental resolution to provide necessary funds for its share of the cost of this improvement if the amount appropriated herein proves to be insufficient to cover said cost.
- 4. It is mutually agreed that the full maintenance and energy costs for the lighting and full maintenance of the newly constructed sidewalk shall be the responsibility of the CITY.

All other terms and conditions of the Agreement not in conflict with this Supplemental Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, each of the parties hereto has caused this Supplemental Agreement to be executed by its duly authorized representative(s) as of the day and year first above written.
