A RESOLUTION  
APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING

THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS AND THE VILLAGE OF SAVOY, ILLINOIS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That a Boundary Agreement by and between the City of Urbana, Illinois and the Village of Savoy, Illinois for marking the boundary between the two municipalities for planning, zoning and annexation purposes, in the form of the copy of said Agreement attached hereto and hereby incorporated by reference, be and the same is hereby authorized and approved.

Section 2. That the Mayor of the City of Urbana, Illinois, be and the same is hereby authorized to execute and deliver and the City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois, be and the same is hereby authorized to attest to said execution of said Agreement as so authorized and approved for and on behalf of the City of Urbana, Illinois.

**SAVOY  
BOUNDARY

## BOUNDARY AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana, Illinois, a Municipal Corporation, a Home Rule unit of local government (hereafter "Urbana") and the Village of Savoy, Illinois, a Municipal Corporation (hereafter "Savoy") desire to enter into an agreement marking the boundary between the two municipalities for planning, zoning and annexation purposes; and

WHEREAS, Article VII Section 10 of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois encourages units of local government to contract or otherwise associate among themselves, to exercise jointly any power or powers, privileges, or authority exercised or which may be exercised by said municipalities individually in any manner not prohibited by law; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of both municipalities to enter into this intergovernmental agreement.

NOW THEREFORE it is agreed by and between the City of Urbana and the Village of Savoy as follows:

1. From and after the effective date of this agreement, Urbana and Savoy hereby agree that the boundary line between the two communities shall be the center line of Wright Street, where such public right-of-way now exists, and to the South of such right-of-way as if Wright Street were actually extended to the

South on a true North/South axis South from the present corporate limits of the City of Urbana. Except as modified in the manner set forth in paragraph 2 below, the line so established shall be the boundary for planning, zoning and annexation purposes. Urbana and Savoy shall only annex or enter into annexation agreements for such property as is on the West side of such line for Savoy and as on the East side of said boundary for Urbana. Neither City shall annex, enter into annexation agreements or attempt to annex except on their side of such line.

2. Recognizing that present statutes require annexation to the far side of adjacent public right-of-way, the parties agree that for a particular parcel it will be necessary that the annexation exceed the center line of Wright Street, such automatic right-of-way annexation shall not be deemed to be a violation of this Agreement. Furthermore, the parties agree to meet and negotiate in good faith concerning the transfer of responsibility for maintenance of Wright Street to lessen the inefficiencies that will be created by a "patchwork" pattern of jurisdiction over Wright Street or Wright Street extended.

3. Contingency. This Agreement shall not be binding upon either municipality until boundary agreements regarding annexation limits are in effect between the City of Urbana and the City of Champaign and the City of Champaign and the Village of Savoy. Nor shall this agreement be binding upon either municipality unless the Urbana-Champaign Sanitary District has entered into an agreement with both the Cities of Champaign and Urbana and the Village of Savoy which said agreement which has the effect of requiring

annexation (or an annexation agreement) with respect to any parcel prior to permitting connection of such parcel to the sanitary sewer of the Urbana-Champaign Sanitary District, or in the absence of such an agreement coming into existence upon the passage of an Ordinance or resolution by each the City of Urbana and the Village of Savoy that this agreement shall be in effect regardless of the fact that no such agreement with the Urbana-Champaign Sanitary District has come into effect.


4. Duration. This agreement shall be binding on the parties unless and until the parties agree otherwise in writing.


5. Recording. The Clerks of the respective Cities shall supply to the other City two (2) copies of this Agreement, executed and certified as to adoption. The Clerk of the City of Urbana shall file a copy of the executed Agreement, so certified as to adoption by both Clerks, with the Champaign County Recorder's Office, and shall notify the Clerk of Savoy as to the date of recording and the recording number.

6. Action Contrary to Law. Nothing contained herein shall require either of the Cities to take any action which would be a violation of law or would cause a default on any obligation or debt instrument.
