

RESOLUTION NO. 9091-R2

A RESOLUTION OF PROTEST

WHEREAS, Mr. Gene Salmon has petitioned the County of Champaign for a rezoning of 33.88 acres of property located at the Southeast Quarter of Section 33, Township 20 North, Range 9 East, Somer Township from AG-2 Agriculture to I-1 Light Industry; and

WHEREAS, the said petition is being considered by various governmental authorities concerned under the style and name of "Champaign County ZBA Case #708-AM-90, Request to rezone 33.88 acres from AG-2 Agriculture to I-1 Light Industry"; and

WHEREAS, The Urbana Plan Commission has considered matters pertaining to said petition at their July 5, 1990 Plan Commission meeting and has forwarded the said petition to the Urbana City Council with its recommendation that the Urbana City Council protest the proposed rezoning due to lack of information on drainage, traffic impacts and lack of an annexation agreement with the petitioner; and

WHEREAS, the Urbana City Council, having duly considered all matters pertaining thereto, finds and determines that the proposed rezoning would not be in the best interests of the City of Urbana and its citizens if granted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. The City Council finds and determines that the facts contained in the above recitations are true.

Section 2. That the Urbana City Council, on behalf of the said City, hereby resolves that the City of Urbana should and hereby does protest the proposed rezoning as set forth in Champaign County ZBA Case 708-AM-90, and urges that it not be approved.
