

A RESOLUTION OF PROTEST

WHEREAS, the Champaign County Zoning Administrator has petitioned the County of Champaign to amend the Champaign County Zoning Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the said petition is being considered by various governmental authorities concerned under the style and name of "Champaign County ZBA Case #752-AT-91, Proposed Amendment to the Champaign County Zoning Ordinance to Revise the Standards for Freestanding On-Premises Signs in the B-1, B-3, B-4, I-1 and I-2 Zoning Districts"; and

WHEREAS, the Urbana Plan Commission has considered matters pertaining to said petition at the April 18, 1991 Plan Commission meeting and has forwarded the said petition to the Urbana City Council with its recommendation that the Urbana City Council protest the proposed amendment to the Champaign County Zoning Ordinance described in said Case #752-AT-91; and

WHEREAS, the Urbana City Council, having duly considered all matters pertaining thereto, finds and determines that the proposed text amendment would negatively impact the City of Urbana and would NOT be in the best interests of the City of Urbana and its citizens if approved.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. The City Council finds and determines that the facts contained in the above recitations are true.


Section 2. That the Urbana City Council, on behalf of the said City, hereby resolves that the City of Urbana should and hereby does protest the proposed amendment to the Champaign County Zoning Ordinance as set forth in Champaign County ZBA Case #752-AT-91, and urges that it not be approved.

Section 3. The City Clerk of the City of Urbana is authorized and directed to file a certified copy of this Resolution of Protest with the County Clerk of the County of Champaign.
