

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING 1991-92 ISWDA BUDGET

WHEREAS, the Urbana City Council, in the course of deliberating the approval of the ISWDA Annual Budget, has identified the following issues as being of crucial importance and thus must be addressed and resolved by the ISWDA Board within a reasonable period of time:

- (1) Allowance for funds to decommission both the proposed Transfer Station and Landfill;
- (2) Expansion of the Escrow Fund to cover costs associated with the potential failure to successfully site a landfill;
- (3) Establishment of a minimum percentage of tipping fees to fund the Escrow Account;
- (4) Provisions to obligate any member that withdraws from the ISWDA to maintain and enforce flow control or provide for equivalent revenues for a minimum period of time;
- (5) Extension of the ISWDA Term of Agreement beyond the likely life of a landfill; and

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana wishes to facilitate implementation of the Champaign County Solid Waste Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana does not wish to delay or interfere with the annual budget process of the ISWDA; and

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana believes that attention to and resolution of the issues stated above will benefit and safeguard the interests of the member governments as well as significantly strengthen the ISWDA.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Urbana, Illinois urges that the five (5) issues detailed above be addressed and resolved by the ISWDA Board in a timely manner but in any event prior to the issuance of bonds for the purpose of construction of a solid waste facility.
