

RESOLUTION NO. 9192-R33

A RESOLUTION
AMENDING HOUSING REHABILITATION PROGRAM OPERATIONAL GUIDELINES
AS ORIGINALLY AUTHORIZED BY RESOLUTION NO. 7576-R26

WHEREAS, on February 2, 1976, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, adopted operational guidelines for implementation of housing rehabilitation programs funded through the Community Development Block Grant program; and

WHEREAS, said operational guidelines have been amended by the City Council from time to time thereafter; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development Commission and Community Development Division of the City of Urbana have formulated revised housing rehabilitation program guidelines entitled Housing Rehabilitation Program Manual 1992-1994 for purposes of 1) administering the Fiscal Year 1992-1993 and Fiscal Year 1993-1994 housing rehabilitation loan and grant programs financed with Community Development Block Grant funds and 2) replacing previously adopted housing rehabilitation program guidelines which needed revision to reflect current housing market conditions and Federal guidelines. A copy of said housing rehabilitation program manual is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That the Community Development Division of the City of Urbana is hereby authorized and directed to proceed with implementation of the housing rehabilitation program guidelines as generally described in the attached Housing Rehabilitation Program Manual 1992-1994, dated June, 1992, which is hereby approved.

Section 2: That the Community Development Division is hereby directed to solicit proposals from financial institutions with offices located within the corporate limits of Urbana for participation in the housing rehabilitation programs as set forth in said housing rehabilitation program manual.
