

RESOLUTION NO. 9293-R11

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDS
FROM THE ILLINOIS AFFORDABLE HOUSING TRUST FUND

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana has administered housing and neighborhood improvement programs funded through the Community Development Block Grant Program since 1975, providing housing rehabilitation and special neighborhood services for low- and moderate-income households; and

WHEREAS, the city's CDBG entitlement grant has decreased significantly in recent years; and

WHEREAS, in 1989, the Illinois General Assembly created the Illinois Affordable Housing Trust Fund to provide additional funds to non-profit agencies through the state for maintenance and development of housing for low-income households; and

WHEREAS, in 1991 the city received \$75,000 in Trust funds for housing rehabilitation in the city's Community Development Target Area, said funds having since been fully obligated; and


WHEREAS, there continues to exist a need for housing and neighborhood improvement programs for low-income households in Urbana.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of Urbana, Illinois, as follows.

1. That the Community Development Division of the City of Urbana is hereby authorized and directed to file an application to the Illinois Housing Development Authority for \$135,000 in Illinois Affordable Housing Trust Funds to be used for housing rehabilitation in the Community Development Target Area.

2. That the Mayor is hereby designated as the authorized representative of the City of Urbana to take any action necessary in connection with said application and to provide such additional information as may be required.
