

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE CITY OF URBANA AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA) COMPLIANCE PLAN

WHEREAS, the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requires municipalities to conduct a self-evaluation to determine their compliance with the ADA and to maintain a copy of the self-evaluation on file for public inspection for three years; and

WHEREAS, City staff consulted Lester Pritchard of the Universal Community Networkers and Sue Johnson-Smith of People Accepting Control of their Environment and held public hearings on July 23, 1992 and September 28, 1992 to assist in the self-evaluation process; and

WHEREAS, City staff has completed the self-evaluation and has prepared an ADA compliance plan; and

WHEREAS, a written copy of the ADA compliance plan, entitled "City of Urbana Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Compliance Plan", has been presented to and is now before this meeting; and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the Council hereby approves and adopts the "City of Urbana Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Compliance Plan" prepared by City staff.

Section 2. That the City Clerk is directed to maintain a copy of the Plan on file and to make it available for public inspection for three years.

Section 3. That City staff shall solicit input from interested parties and report to the City Council ~~on~~ ^{CITY OF} March 23 concerning any additional planning and actions needed to comply with the spirit of the ADA, including contingency plans in case of failure to complete city building and library annexes on a schedule adequate for such compliance.
