

RESOLUTION NO. 9293-R22

A RESOLUTION ASKING GOVERNOR EDGAR TO SUPPORT MUNICIPALITIES
RELATIVE TO THE INCOME TAX SURCHARGE

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has shared with local governments, municipalities and counties, with needed revenues since 1989 with income tax surcharge proceeds; and

WHEREAS, the temporary income tax surcharge for municipalities and counties will expire on June 30, 1993; and

WHEREAS, municipalities and counties have tremendous financial needs to directly serve the citizens of Illinois with local programs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana has expended the revenues in a conservative, productive manner for its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Federal and State government continue to impose unfunded state mandates on local governments; and

WHEREAS, this revenue is essential to sound municipal and county fiscal health; and

WHEREAS, Governor Edgar will be delivering the State Budget Address on March 3, 1993;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That this corporate body, a political subdivision of the State, does hereby request that the Governor support and endorse in the 1993 Budget Address the permanent extension of the income tax surcharge with the proceeds dedicated to municipalities and counties.

Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to convey this Resolution to the Governor, legislators and the Illinois Municipal League.
