

RESOLUTION NO. 9394-R10

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO PARTICIPATION BY ELECTED OFFICIALS IN THE ILLINOIS MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT FUND

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana, Illinois, a municipal corporation, has been a participant in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund for many years; and

WHEREAS, the Urbana City Council did, on May 16, 1977, pass Resolution No. 7677-R65, which Resolution established the eligibility of the Office of Mayor of the City of Urbana to participate in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund; and

WHEREAS, the said Resolution in making the Office of Mayor eligible for participation in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund, determined that the Office of Mayor normally required performance of duty for six hundred (600) hours or more per year; and

WHEREAS, the Urbana City Council also passed Resolution No. 8586-R21 on the 17th day of February, 1986, which Resolution, pursuant to a statute so authorizing, raised the minimum "floor" for eligibility to participate in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund to one thousand (1,000) hours per year; and

WHEREAS, the effect of the later Resolution (8586-R21) on the earlier Resolution (7677-R65) is unclear and Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund has asked the City to clarify it; and

WHEREAS, it is recognized by the City Council that the performance of the duties of the Mayor has at least since May 1, 1989, required in excess of one thousand (1,000) hours per year, and such fact should be formally recognized and the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund be so advised.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE URBANA CITY COUNCIL THAT this governing body finds and determines that the Office of Mayor of the City of Urbana normally requires the performance of duty for one thousand (1,000) hours or more per year.

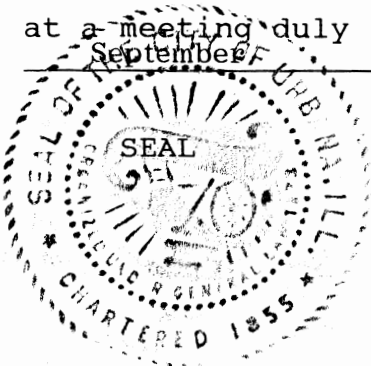
