A RESOLUTION REGARDING RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

 $\underline{\text{Section 1.}}$ That the Director of Public Works take the necessary steps for the Council to be able to consider a contract or contracts for the curbside collection of Recyclable Materials from all single or multi-family dwellings of six or fewer units within the corporate limits of the City no later than July 3, 1995.

Section 2. That the contract or contracts should include the following provisions:

- Curbside collection
- Weekly service 2.
- Identifiable containers with City U-Cycle logo
- Collection of materials designated by the City which may include clear, brown, and green food and beverage (f&b) glass containers, f&b steel (tin), bi-metal, and aluminum can containers, newspaper (ONP), blow molded polyethylene terephthalate (PET, plastic code #1) and high density polyethylene (HDPE, plastic code #2) plastic containers, corrugated cardboard (OCC), chipboard, magazines (OMG), or other materials.
- Verification of processing of Recyclable Materials
- Reporting of volume of Recyclable Materials participation rates
- 7. Adequate insurance protection
- Adequate performance security
- Default and termination procedures
