

RESOLUTION NO. 9495-R27

A RESOLUTION REGARDING LARGE MULTIFAMILY RECYCLING.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Works take the necessary steps for the Council to be able to consider alternatives for the collection of Recyclable Materials from multi-family dwellings of seven or more units within the corporate limits of the City no later than August 1, 1995, including issuing a statement of interest no later than June 15, 1995.

Section 2. That the statement of interest should include the following provisions:

1. Identifiable containers with City U-Cycle logo
2. Collection of materials designated by the City which may include clear, brown, and green food and beverage (f&b) glass containers, f&b steel (tin), bi-metal, and aluminum can containers, newspaper (ONP), blow molded polyethylene terephthalate (PET, plastic code #1) and high density polyethylene (HDPE, plastic code #2) plastic containers, corrugated cardboard (OCC), chipboard, magazines (OMG), or other materials.
3. Verification of processing of Recyclable Materials
4. Reporting of volume of Recyclable Materials and participation rates
5. Adequate insurance protection
6. Adequate performance security
7. Default and termination procedures


