

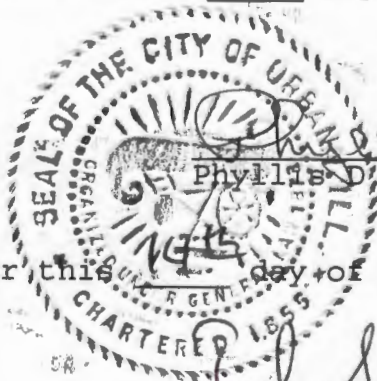
RESOLUTION NO. 9697-R13

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING STAFF TO NOTIFY RESIDENTS OF
BLOCKS WHERE PARKING METERS ARE PROPOSED

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,
ILLINOIS, as follows:

The Urbana City Council shall not vote on any ordinance which directs the creation of a parking meter zone for any area on any street right-of-way where there does not already exist a parking meter zone unless the Mayor declares to the Council that he is satisfied that the City staff has caused a copy of the proposed ordinance, together with notice of the date the Council shall next have such matter on their written agenda, to be mailed addressed to "Resident" of each residential unit abutting upon the street right-of-way where such parking meter zones are proposed to be located thirty (30) days prior to the day of such Council meeting wherein the matter is pending. A bona fide effort to mail such information shall be made, but the receipt of such by the persons to whom it was directed shall not be regarded as a precondition for the Council to vote on such ordinance.
