

RESOLUTION NO. 9697-R29

A RESOLUTION ALLOCATING THE FOURTH PUBLIC,
EDUCATION, & GOVERNMENT (PEG) CHANNEL FOR
USE BY THE UNIVERSITY OF ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Urbana representatives to the Champaign-Urbana Cable and Telecommunications Commission (formerly the Champaign-Urbana Joint CATV Commission) developed a plan ("the Plan") regarding the Public, Education, and Government (PEG) access channels, which was adopted by the Urbana City Council on April 3, 1995 in Resolution No. 9495-R21; and

WHEREAS, the Plan adopted by Resolution 9495-R21 includes an allocation of the four PEG access channels; and

WHEREAS, the Plan contemplates the use of the fourth PEG channel by the University of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the University of Illinois, by letter dated January 16, 1997, from the office of the Chancellor, has outlined proposed programming that appears to be consistent with the Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the Council approves of the allocation of the fourth PEG access channel for use by the University of Illinois in a manner consistent with the proposed programming.


This Resolution is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.


