RESOLUTION NO. 9899-R1

A RESOLUTION TO REVISE THE POLICY CONCERNING TRAVEL EXPENSES FOR COUNCIL MEMBERS

WHEREAS, it is desirable that members of the City Council attend conferences relating to the conduct of city business; and

WHEREAS, it is reasonable that the travel and living expenses associated with attendance at such conferences should be paid for out of city funds;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

Section 1. Resolution No. 9293-R36 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. It shall be the policy of the City Council that each Alderperson shall be entitled to be reimbursed for their travel and living expenses, including meals and lodging and incidental such expenses to attend one conference relating to City matters at a location outside of the State of Illinois in each fiscal year while such person is serving as an Alderperson. Each City Council member shall have the discretion to select a conference which, in his or her best judgment, relates to City matters.
