

RESOLUTION NO. 1999-03-011R

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE URBANA SCHOOL DISTRICT #116 APRIL 13, 1999
TAX REFERENDUM QUESTION

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana is committed to the general health and welfare of our community, including the education of its citizenry; and

WHEREAS, the physical educational environment in which children learn is important to the overall educational process; and

WHEREAS, District #116 has identified certain school buildings which are in need of renovation and improvement; and

WHEREAS, District #116 has researched and developed a plan to renovate and expand Urbana Middle School and Leal School; and

WHEREAS, funding for a major technology upgrade, planned over a four year period, is included in the referendum package; and

WHEREAS, District #116 has developed a plan along with the Urbana Park District to construct a swimming pool on the high school-middle school campus; and

WHEREAS, a financially feasible plan for construction, operation, and maintenance of the pool has been developed in partnership with the Urbana Park District, thus providing a benefit to both organizations; and

WHEREAS, the referendum package does not include a tax increase; and

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana has confidence in the process followed by District #116 to gather and consider input from its various constituencies in developing its plans and in the financial integrity of the proposed plan.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

The City of Urbana supports the Urbana School District #116 referendum on April 13 to renovate and upgrade the Urbana Middle School and Leal Elementary School buildings, build and equip an indoor pool at the Urbana High/Middle School campus, and provide technology equipment and improvements at all of the school buildings in the district.
