

RESOLUTION NO.: 1999-06-027R  
A RESOLUTION CLARIFYING A SPECIAL USE ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Urbana approved Ordinance No. 9596-45 on November 9, 1995 granting Champaign County a special use for offices in the Brookens Administrative Center; and

WHEREAS, the conditions of that special use included the restriction that courts or court-related uses are not allowed at Brookens Administrative Center; and

WHEREAS, court-related uses are defined to specifically include the States Attorney's Office; and

WHEREAS, Champaign County is undergoing a master site planning process of the Champaign County Court House and related facilities for downtown Urbana; and

WHEREAS, the process of said planning and reconstruction is a multi-year process; and

WHEREAS, Champaign County has requested that the State's Attorney's Support Enforcement Program, in conjunction with the Illinois Department of Public Aid, be consolidated at Brookens; and

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana and Champaign County are working cooperatively on County Courthouse needs.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That although Ordinance No. 9596-45 explicitly prohibits the relocation of the State's Attorney's Office to Brookens Administrative Center, since the County is undergoing a significant downtown investment and is in a state of transition as it conducts its space needs programming and construction it is beneficial for the State's Attorney's Office' Support Enforcement Program to be located at Brookens Administrative Center at this time, pending the results of the master site planning process and subsequent construction.

Section 2. That the Urbana City Council, does hereby authorize the State's Attorney's Support Enforcement Program to locate at Brookens Administrative Center for a period of one year, renewable annually based upon review of the County's master site planning process and construction.

APPROVED by the Mayor this 25th day of June, 1999.
