

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-01-003R

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE OFFICE OF THE CITY ATTORNEY TO  
INTERVENE IN A REQUEST FOR TAX EXEMPTION

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana has received notice from The Carle Foundation that it seeks exemption from property taxation for a parcel of property located at 810 W. Anthony Drive, Urbana; and

WHEREAS, the application for exemption reveals that at least a portion of the property may be used for non-exempt purposes; and

WHEREAS, City desires to ensure that the record reflects all information necessary for determining that some or all of the property qualifies for exemption from property taxation; and


WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has requested to intervene on behalf of the City, by letter to the Champaign County Board of Review, dated January 10, 2000;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That the office of the City Attorney is hereby authorized to intervene in the above-referenced request for exemption, and the previously-mailed request for such intervention is hereby ratified and approved by this Council.

This Resolution is hereby passed by the affirmative vote of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.

PASSED by the City Council this 18th day of January, 2000.
