WHEREAS, the Petitioners deserve a prompt response from the City Council as to whether their request for annexation will be honored; and

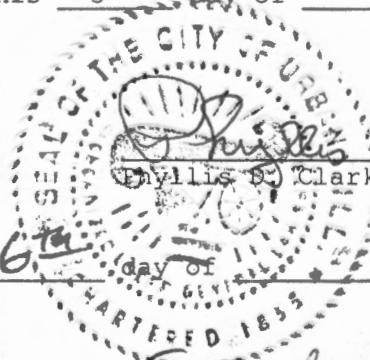
