## A RESOLUTION OF PROTEST AGAINST A PROPOSED TEXT AMENDMENT TO THE CHAMPAIGN COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE

(Text Amendment Creating Categories of Land Use for Electric Power Generating Facilities, High Impact Wind Turbine Facilities, Gas Turbine Peak Plants, and Low Impact Wind Turbine Facilities -Plan Case CCZEA 236 AT-00

WHEREAS, Frank DiNovo Chambaign County Zoning Administrator, has petitioned the County of Chambaign for an amendment to the text of the Champaign County Zoning Ordinance in Champaign County ZBA Case No. 236-AT-00 with respect to the following: creation of decegories of land use for electric power generating facilities: high impact wind turbine facilities; gas turbine peaker plance; and low impact wind turbine facilities; and WHEREAS, said amendment has been submitted to the City of Urbana for review and is being considered by the City of Urbana under the name of "CCZBA-236-AT-00: Text Amendment Creating Categories of Land Use for Electric Power Generating Facilities, High Impact Wind Turbine Facilities, Gas Turbine Peak Plants, and Low Impact Wind Turbine Facilities"; and

WHEREAS, the Urbana Plan Commission, after considering matters pertaining to said Petition at their meeting of September 21, 2000, has recommended by a vote of 5 to 1 that the Urbana City Council defeat a resolution of protest against the proposed text amendment to the Champaign County Zoning Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Urbana City Council, having duly considered all matters pertaining thereto, finds and determines that the proposed text amendment is in the best interest of the City of Urbana. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

contained in the above recitations are true.
Section 2. That the Urbana City Council hereby resolves that the City
of Urbana, pursuant to the provisions of 35 ILCS 5/5-12014, does hereby
defeat a Resolution of Protest against the proposed text amendment as
presented in CCZEA-235-AT-00.
