A RESOLUTION OF PROTEST AGAINST A PROPOSED MAP AMENDMENT TO THE CHAMPAIGN COUNTY ZONING MAP

(A 19-Acre Tract of Land on the East Side of North Lincoln Avenue / Bill Cope and Mary Kalantis)

WHEREAS, Bill Cope and Mary Kalantis have petitioned the County of Champaign in Champaign County ZBA Case No. 578 AM-06 to change the zoning map to apply the Rural Residential Overlay (RRO) zoning designation to a 19 acre tract of land on the East lide of North Lincoln Avenue currently zoned both CR Conservation Recreation and AG-2 Agricultural; and

WHEREAS, the Urbana City Council, having duly considered all matters pertaining thereto, finds and determines that the proposed map amendment is not in the best interest of the City of Urbana.
