

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-09-049R

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT WITH
AMERICAN FEDERATION OF STATE, COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES,
AFL-CIO, COUNCIL 31, LOCAL 1331
(Term of July 1, 2013, through June 30, 2016)

WHEREAS, the duly authorized representatives of the City of Urbana in good faith have negotiated a three-year collective bargaining agreement ("Agreement") with the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, Council 31, Local 1331 ("AFSCME"), concerning wages, hours, terms, and other conditions of employment for the term of July 1, 2013, through June 30, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement has been lawfully and properly ratified by the membership of AFSCME; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the best interests of the City are served by executing the Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1.

The collective bargaining agreement between the City of Urbana and AFSCME, in substantially the form of the copy of said Agreement attached hereto and hereby incorporated by reference, be and the same is hereby authorized and approved.

Section 2.

The Mayor of the City of Urbana, Illinois, be and the same is hereby authorized to execute and deliver, and the City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois, be and the same is authorized to attest to, said execution of said

Agreement as so authorized and approved for and on behalf of the City of Urbana, Illinois.

Section 3.

The City Clerk shall transmit a certified copy of this Resolution to Jason Scott, President, AFSCME Local 1331.

Section 4.

The City Council authorizes disbursement of all necessary retroactive pay as provided in the collective bargaining agreement.


