RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF IMPROVED LEGISLATION TO PROTECT
DRINKING WATER

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana, Illinois has worked with other local governments and citizens' groups to protect the Mahomet Aquifer, the source of our drinking water; and

WHEREAS, supporters of protecting the Mahomet Aquifer all recognize the need for new legislation at the state and federal levels to better protect water from pollution and to ensure effective monitoring of environmental laws; and

WHEREAS, we recognize the need for continued public discussion, education and action on the issue of protecting water supplies; and

WHEREAS, the value of a working coalition to continue this effort is clearly necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Urbana is committed to continue working with its coalition partners in government, citizens' groups and the private sector to get improved legislation to protect drinking water in the State of Illinois and at the federal level.

PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL this 5th day of October, 2015.


