A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT STATE OF ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY AGREEMENT – RAPE ADVOCACY, COUNSELING, & EDUCATION SERVICES – SURVIVOR SERVICES-TRAUMA THERAPY

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana (the "City") is a home rule unit of local government pursuant to Article VII, Section 6, of the Illinois Constitution, 1970, and may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, and the passage of this Resolution constitutes an exercise of the City's home rule powers and functions as granted in the Illinois Constitution, 1970; and

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (the DCEO) has awarded a grant ("Grant") in the amount of \$2,000,000 to the City for community development, violence prevention, and administrative costs; and

WHEREAS, on September 26, 2022, the Urbana City Council passed Resolution No. 2022-09-074R approving the acceptance of the DCEO Grant City; and

WHEREAS, Rape Advocacy, Counseling, & Education Services ("RACES") has heretofore expressed their intent to operate a Survivor Services-Trauma Therapy program utilizing DCEO violence prevention funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That an Agreement providing twenty five thousand and 00/100 dollars (\$25,000.00) to RACES so as to operate and administer Survivor Services-Trauma Therapy in substantially the same form of said Agreement attached hereto and hereby incorporated by reference, be and the same is hereby authorized and approved.

Section 2. That the Mayor of the City of Urbana, Illinois, be and the same is hereby authorized to execute and deliver and the City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois, be and the same is authorized to attest to said execution of said Agreement as so authorized and approved for and on behalf of the City of Urbana, Illinois.
